

Final Review Requirements

- ❑ **Original Final Project Body of Work:** Presentation must consist of completed scope of work approved at Midpoint Review. This must include a full written business plan, product development samples (if applicable), and a visual presentation.

- ❑ **Original Directed Study Journal** (18 units): The required Directed Study Journal will be reviewed by the Committee, and will be returned to you at the end of the review.

- ❑ **Final Project Presentation**
 - a. **Written: Final Project Written Business Plan** must be turned in two weeks prior to your Review date. Please submit 2 hard copies, **bound** and of professional quality, along with 1 CD of the Final Thesis Project Summary in PDF format, saved as only 1 file, to the Final Review Coordinator, 79 New Montgomery Street. Cover page must specify the following:
 - Title of Project (mandatory)
 - One sentence describing project (e.g.. ‘A merchandising solution for a line of purses..)
 - Student’s Name and ID
 - Major
 - Date of Final Review

 - b. **Oral:** Come prepared to give a professional oral presentation. It should consist of an overview of your work and be no more than 30 minutes in duration. Use of PowerPoint is highly recommended.

- ❑ **Final Project for Library**
 - a. **Format:** The Department requires you to submit 2 copies of visuals (CD, slides etc.) documenting your Final Project and any prints to be archived in the AAU library. Bring to the Final Review.

 - b. **Archival Box:** It must be paper, not plastic and acid free. Your Final Project Visuals must fit inside. It may be purchased at Patrick’s Office supply, on Mission at 2nd Street. It should be 9”x12” and cost generally runs \$13.00. Bring to the Final Review.

All materials submitted must be clearly labeled with your name, student ID number, date of Final Review and Major. If your materials are incomplete, the granting of your degree will be delayed.
