

FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS

Applicants to the Graduate Program should complete the Free Application For Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as early as possible. Within 5 to 7 days after you have submitted your completed FAFSA application electronically to the Department of Education, the University will receive the information and can begin the awarding process.

At the Graduate level, all students are considered “Independent” and qualify for student loans under those guidelines. Students enrolled at least half time (6 units) may qualify for a total of \$20,500 in Federal direct student loans per academic year.
